
Several reasons led to this choice, including the following:

- The degree obtained from San Dámaso provides wide opportunities for post-graduate studies in many fields related to our specific vocation and mission.
- Women from our territory will have the opportunity live outside of their country, thus experiencing the internationality of our association of consecrated women. They will also be learning the official language of our association early in their consecrated life.
- The tuition is very economical, far lower than anything found in the United States even with the discounts offered by some of the Universities we looked into.

Please remember these young women in your prayers as they continue the adventure of following after The One who leads them far and wide in building his Kingdom of peace and love!
